

Job Title	Job Description
Robot Control Advisors	Works directly with teams and other event staff to make sure that all robots stay functional on the wireless network. Must have key understanding of robot control system used in the FIRST Global robot kits.
Field Technical Advisors	Ensures robots are functioning on any given field during the rounds of play.
Award Judges	Responsible for judging teams on the field for qualitative and quantitative awards.
Referees	Responsible for calling points, penalties, and have indepth knowledge of all game rules. They are responsible for the smooth operation of all rounds of play.
Scorekeeper	Responsible for keeping score. Scorekeepers must understand the scoring system and abide by the referees decision.
Mobile Machine Shop Attendant	Responsible for ensuring Machine Shop is tidy and organized at all time. Must have great understanding of all the parts in the robot kit and be able to answer questions about spare parts.
Flying Squad	Flying Squad is responsible for being on-call at all times to go and assist any team having issues with their robot. Mechanical or Electrical expertise desired.
Inspectors	Mechanical and Software positions available. Inspectors will check the robots on July 15th before the first practice rounds, and be on-call to inspect robots before matches to ensure compliance with FIRST Global's rules and regulations.
Spare Parts	Responsible for managing the Spare Parts booth. Must have good understanding of robots and all the parts of the robot kit. Must be able to answer questions about parts.
FIRST Global Representative	Responsible for being the face of FIRST Global. Representatives know everything about FIRST Global and may serve as VIP escorts for certain guests.
Emcee/Game Announcers	Responsible for giving play-by-play analysis of games and post-match interviews with students. Keeps the crowd engaged and can explain technical and non technical moves.
Registration	Responsible for checking-in both participating international teams and volunteers. Knows general information about the event.
Queuers/Field Runners	Responsible for ensuring all teams are in the correct positions before a match. This includes strategy area, and ensuring they are "on-deck" ready to take the field as soon as the match before theirs is over. Must be ready to go find a team when they cannot be located.
Pit Admin	Manages items provided for teams at the FIRST Global games and serves as a point of contact for questions from teams and the general public
Pit Runners	Locates competing teams when they are not in their designated areas. Assists in general tasks in keeping the pits in order.
Field Resetters	Quickly resets fields in between matches. Ensures fields are returned to their original condition and are ready for the next group of teams and their robots. During match play, responsible for keeping the flow of play going by feeding the particle balls and contaminate particle balls through the river.
Photographer	Takes professional grade photos throughout the event for use during the event and in the future. Must have experience.
Videographer	Assists the video staff in recording video throughout the event, both on the field and off, for use during the event and after. Must have experience.
Practice Field Supervisors	Answers any questions about rules, helps reset fields after teams finish practicing, and is able to answer questions about rules.

Team Ambassadors	Responsible for connecting with an assigned team from around the world. Each Team Ambassador is paired with a competing team and will be their main escort throughout the event. Commitment to the duration of the event is imperative.
Logistics Crew	Responsible for setting up all equipment (fields, judges area, pits, etc.) and helping ensure sinanage is properly placed. This position can be combined with other positions during the event.
Signage	Responsible for ensureing signage is properly placed both around the D.A.R. Constitution Hall and surrounding area. This position is part of set-up and break-down (July 13-14; July 19) and can be combined with other positions during the event.
Airport Greeters	Assists staff at either Dulles or Reagan National Airports on July 14th to assist with greeting teams as they arrive, and helping them get to the accommodations site.
